Board Bullets

- Approved moving Canyon Crest Elementary School to single-track year-round beginning in the 2010-11 school year.
- Approved the 2010-11 and the 2011-12 school year calendars, reflecting status quo.
- Accepted a Memorandum of Understanding between FUSD and the City of Fontana setting forth a concurrent jurisdiction for both agencies as it pertains to the School Police Department and its dealings with the Fontana Police Department, indicating that either agency can take police action anywhere within the joint jurisdiction of the city or the school district.
- Approved a letter to be sent to the San Bernardino County Superintendent of Schools requesting an explanation as to why Arrowhead Credit Union is involved in the distribution of direct deposits and what financial compensation Arrowhead Credit Union receives for this involvement.

API & AYP Presentation

Kimberly MacKinney, Director of Secondary Instruction, presented the recently released State academic achievement data and there is much good news to celebrate. All Fontana elementary schools scored at least 700 and eight Fontana elementary schools scored 800 or above on the API. Twenty-seven Fontana schools met or exceeded their Schoolwide API Growth Target! Of those, the API of twenty-two schools went up by 21 points or more.
